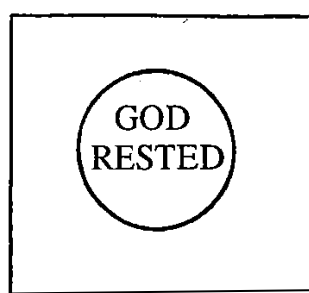
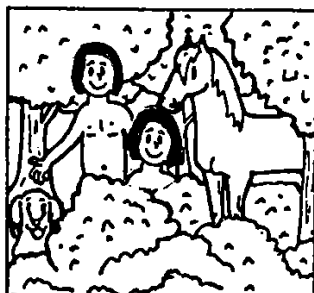
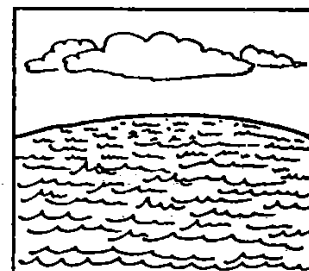
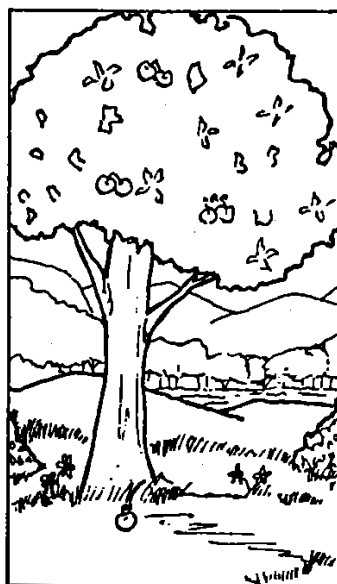
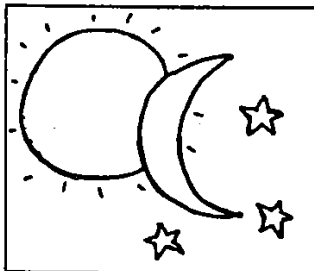
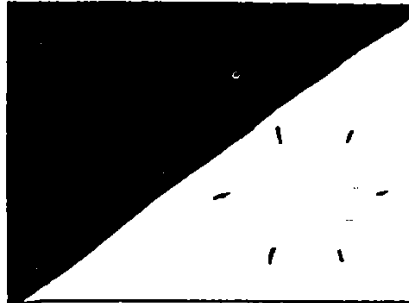
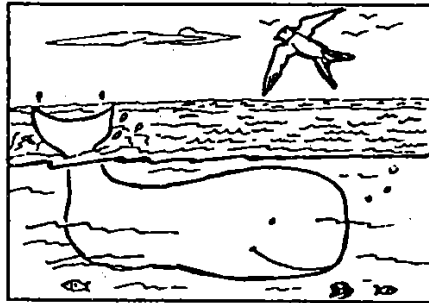
Ask these questions to someone from your Bible Club.

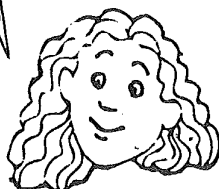
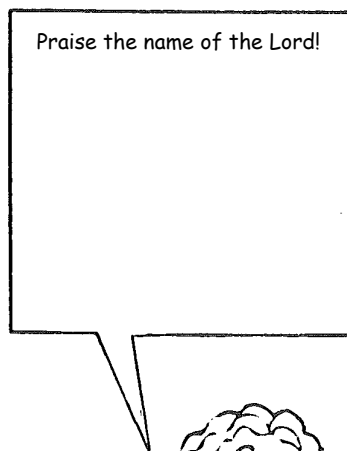

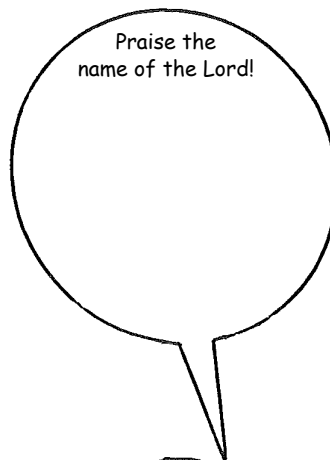
