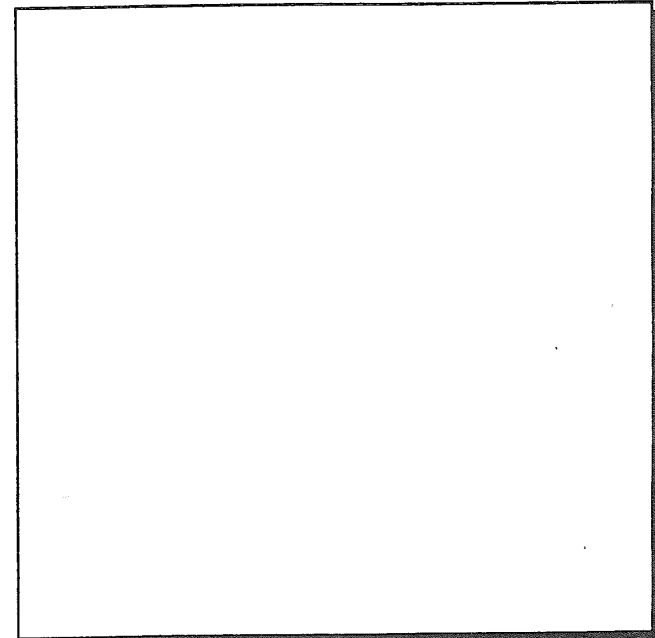


If you do what is right,

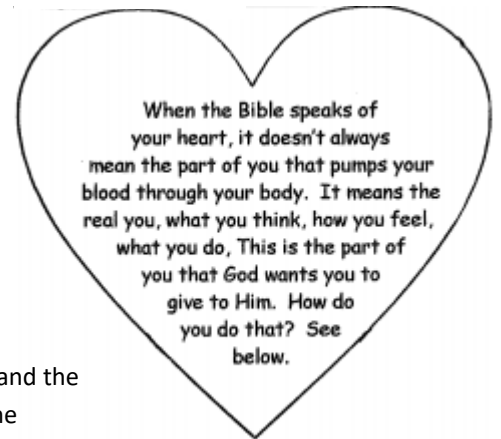
