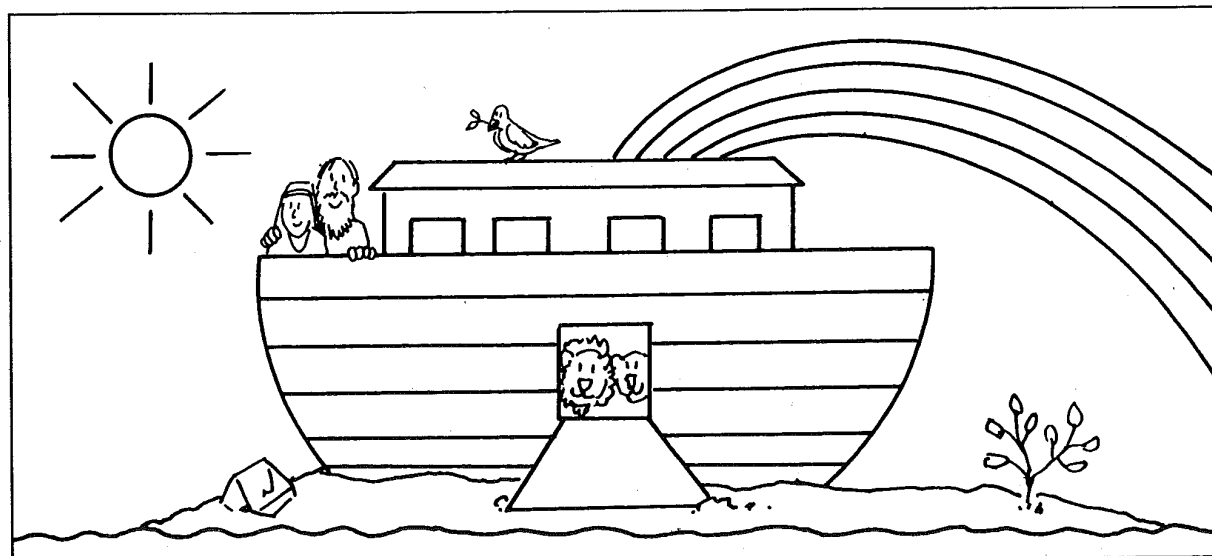
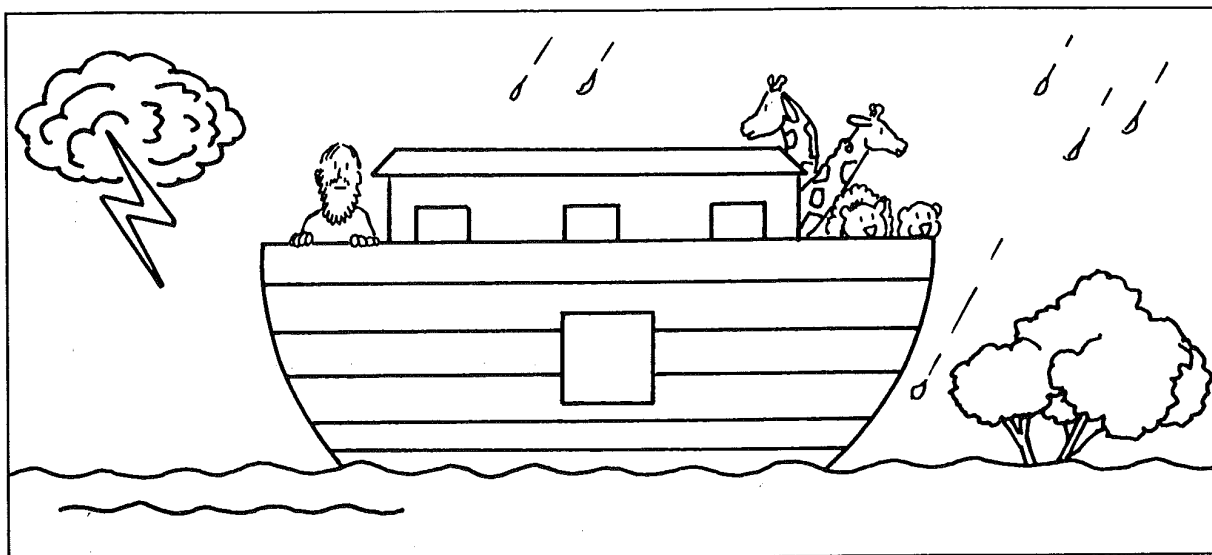
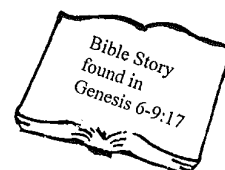
### CAN YOU ANSWER THESE?
