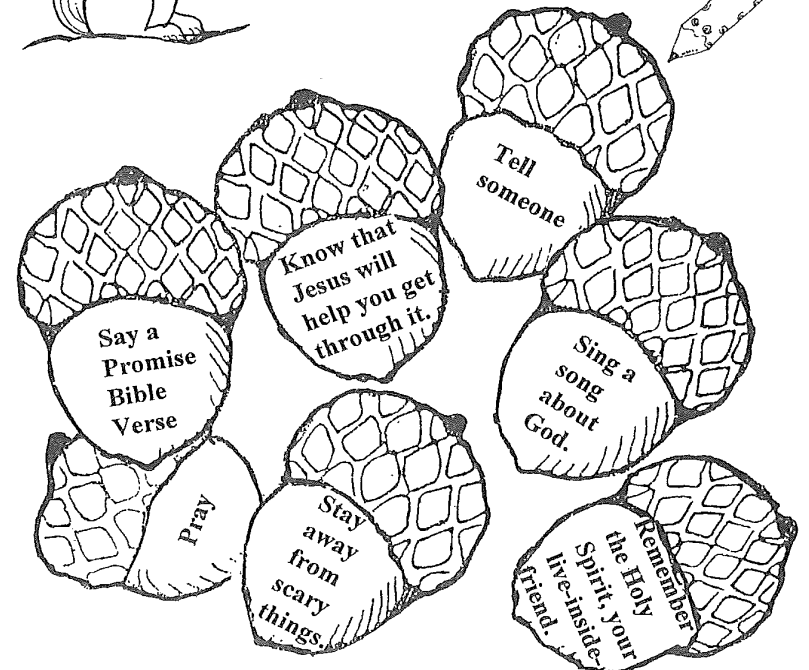


What have you done before when you were afraid?

God said to Abraham, "Do not be afraid, I am your shield." Genesis 15:1

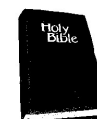
When you are afraid, remember who GOD is!
