Remember to talk to the person you have lied to and ask for their forgiveness, too.

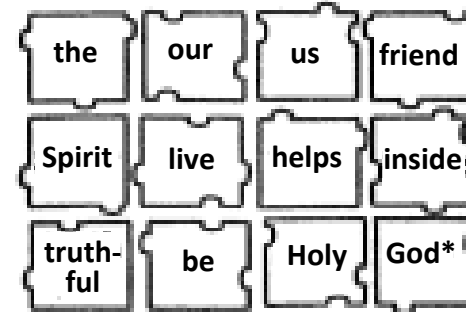
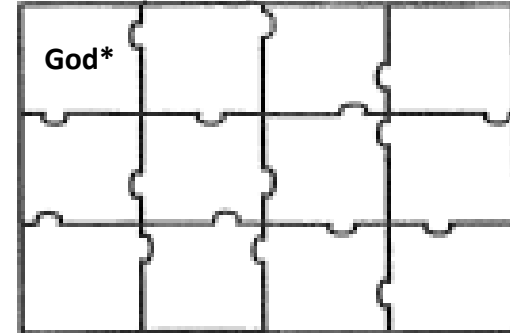


What do I do if I have told a lie?
