Give us this day our daily bread

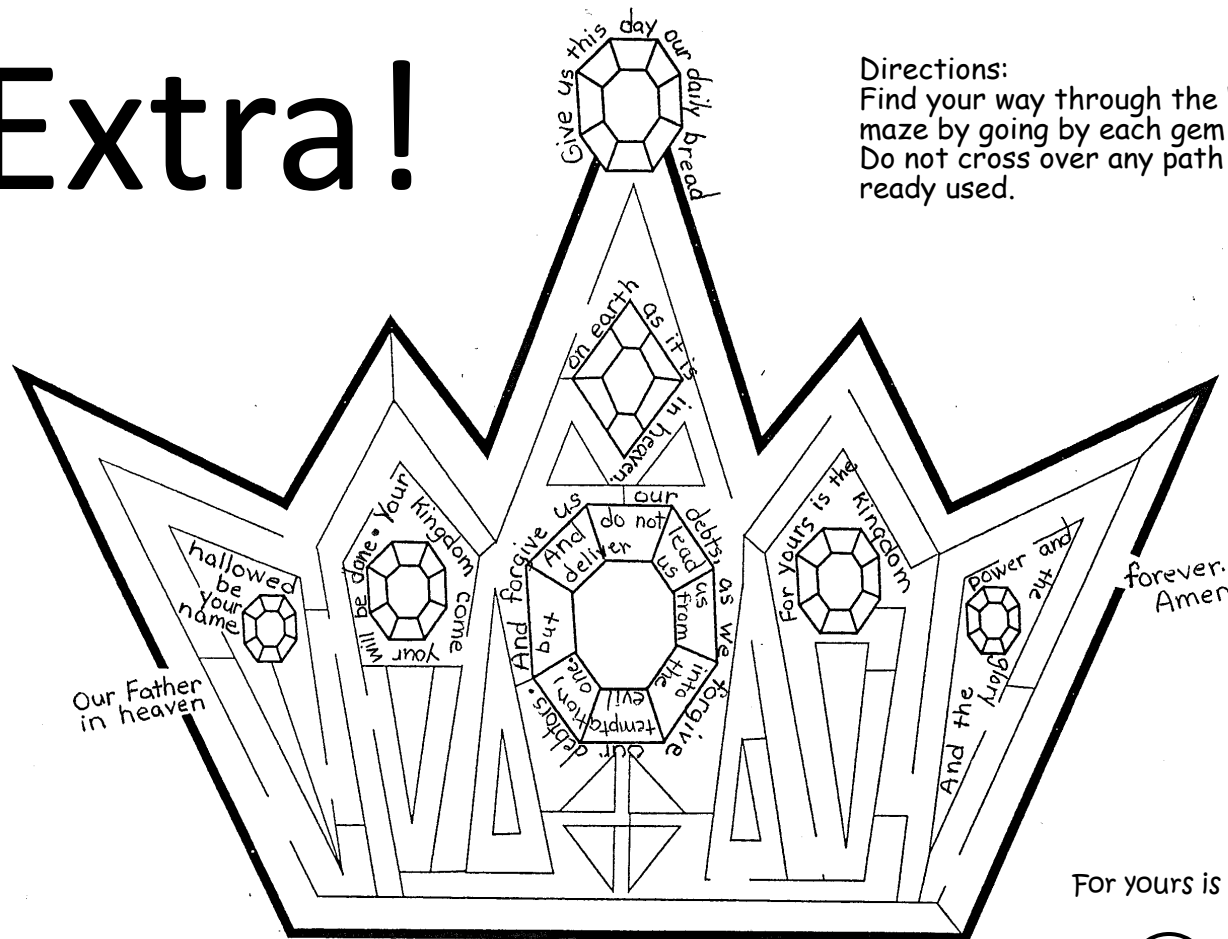
And forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors.
