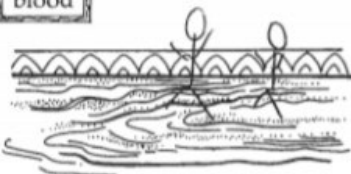


LESSON 4

God will give you His power, too. What is a problem you have that you know you need God's POWER for? (Remember: *nothing* is too hard for God!)

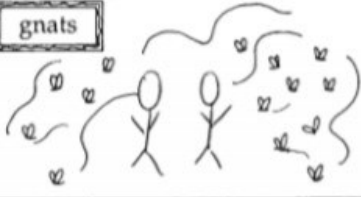

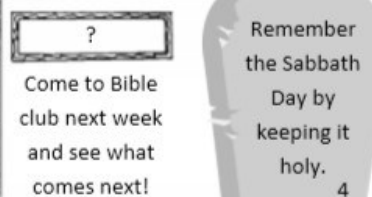
