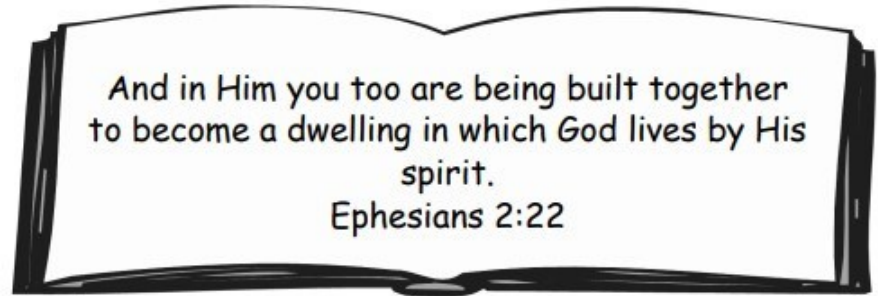
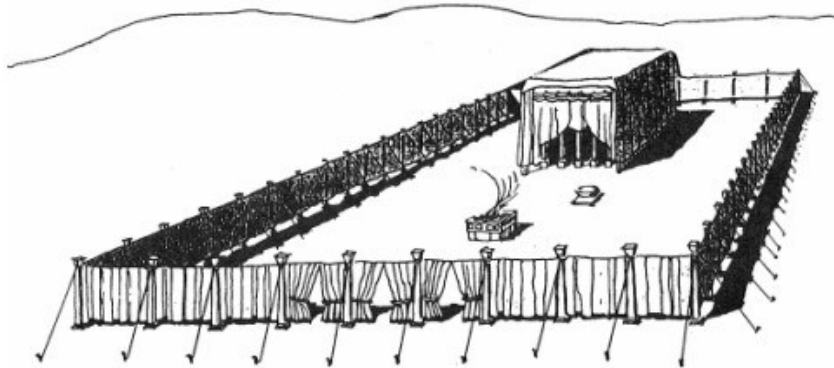
The Tabernacle is a picture for us of God's gift of GOD WITH ME. Just as God wanted to live among His people, He wants to live with us, too.
